- If diagnostic tests are required, the large patient is referred to offices where diagnostic equipment has an appropriate weight maximum – if unsure, the provider's staff follows up to find diagnostic equipment that will handle the patient's weight
- Any counseling about exercise is done so without linking it to weight or weight reduction
- The healthcare professional is open to questions the patient may have about alternative therapies or health solutions

Comments about this Healthcare Provider:

I have addressed my concerns with being treated poorly in regards to my weight and the healthcare provider assured me that their sole purpose is to try and alleviate any pain the patient may have, not to judge them on their weight or make them feel unnecessarily uncomfortable.

Comments about the Facility or Equipment:

The chairs in the waiting room all have arms though they do provide benches and extra wide chairs for the patients ease. They do have exam tables that are not bolted down but are wider and closer to the ground than I have found before, the tables I have observed all have sturdy step up for ease though I have never been asked to get on one for an examination; I was always either standing or sitting in a chair. Any treatment is done in the surgery center that is attached and are done on gurney type beds.
